




Lesson Topic	Trapped
Scripture reference	Genesis 6v 5 - 22
Opening Activity	Can you think of a time when you regretted doing something? What was it? God also had regrets.
Read Bible Passage Genesis 6 v 5 - 22	<p>5The Lord saw that the human beings on the earth were very wicked. He also saw that their thoughts were only about evil all the time. 6The Lord was sorry he had made human beings on the earth. His heart was filled with pain. 7So the Lord said, “I will destroy all human beings that I made on the earth. And I will destroy every animal and everything that crawls on the earth. I will also destroy the birds of the air. This is because I am sorry that I have made them.” 8But Noah pleased the Lord.</p> <p>9This is the family history of Noah. Noah was a good man. He was the most innocent man of his time. He walked with God. 10Noah had three sons: Shem, Ham and Japheth. 11People on earth did what God said was evil. Violence was everywhere. 12And God saw this evil. All people on the earth did only evil. 13So God said to Noah, “People have made the earth full of violence. So I will destroy all people from the earth. 14Build a boat of cypress wood for yourself. Make rooms in it and cover it inside and outside with tar. 15This is how big I want you to build the boat: 450 feet long, 75 feet wide and 45 feet high. 16Make an opening around the top of the boat. Make it 18 inches high from the edge of the roof down. Put a door in the side of the boat. Make an upper, middle and lower deck in it. 17I will bring a flood of water on the earth. I will destroy all living things that live under the sky. This includes everything that has the breath of life. Everything on the earth will die. 18But I will make an agreement with you. You, your sons, your wife and your sons’ wives will all go into the boat. 19Also, you must bring into the boat two of every living thing, male and female. Keep them alive with you. 20There will be two of every kind of bird, animal and crawling thing. They will come to you to be kept alive. 21Also gather some of every kind of food. Store it on the boat as food for you and the animals.” 22Noah did everything that God commanded him.</p>

Discussion questions	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. What did <i>God</i> regret doing? 2. Why was <i>God</i> going to destroy the humans? (<i>Think about why God created man</i>) 3. How does <i>God</i> feel about sin? (<i>Hint: God is Holy</i>) 4. Do you agree with <i>God's</i> plan? Explain.
Explain Bible Passage	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>God</i> regretted making human beings. Their thoughts, hearts and actions were wicked. They did not love <i>God</i> nor serve Him. • There was one man who was righteous (being in a right relationship with <i>God</i>). His name was Noah! • Noah loved <i>God</i> and served Him faithfully. Unlike the rest of the people on the earth. Noah was living his purpose. <i>God's</i> purpose for man is to have relationship with Him. A relationship of love and obedience to <i>God</i>. • Here in this story we see how <i>God</i> feels about sin. <i>God</i> hates sin! Sin separates us from <i>God</i>. Sin prevents us from having that relationship with <i>God</i>. Sin takes away our love for <i>God</i> and our obedience to Him. And that makes <i>God</i> very sad. • <i>God</i> allowed Noah, his family and the animals to be trapped for a while because the earth was being destroyed with a flood. <i>God</i> needed to deal with the sinful people. <i>God</i> gave the people on the earth time to repent but they refused.
Challenge	<p>Allow <i>God</i> to use this lockdown to test our hearts and actions, to see if it is submitted to Him. If it is not, then we have time to repent and surrender our lives to <i>God</i>.</p>




Connect the dots to see what Noah built.




